**Date and time** Monday 6 September 2010 - 7:46am

<b>Current Weather Conditions</b>	 <b>Light snow has been falling in the village throughout the morning, giving us a welcomed top up.</b> It is -2C and -6C with wind-chill with a light to moderate breeze from the west. The <a href="#">BOM</a> says to expect scattered snowfalls today with similar winds.

<b>Current Snow Conditions</b>	<b>A further 5cm of new snow has settled across the resort overnight, making it 13cm since yesterday morning.</b> There is a fresh spring cover to enjoy with some nice powder stashes on a good base.			
<b>Skiing and Snowboarding</b>	Conditions are improving thanks to the new snow. Go hunting for some fresh spring powder, it should be pretty good out there. The groomed runs too will be in nice touch, with a silky fresh layer on top.			
<b>Perisher Valley</b>	Towers Run for the more advanced is rated A1 by the groomers today, perhaps also try Sun Valley as well for some off-piste lines. Beginners, try Snowy Trails, it will be a smooth glide through the trees.			
<b>Smiggin Holes</b>	Wood Run has been revitalised and will be fun for beginners. First time skiers and boarders get your acts together in J Bar Land it is the place for easy turns.			
<b>Blue Cow</b>	Advanced riders in Blue Cow will be delighted with Zali's and Excelerator. They have both bounced back nicely and are ready to rip into.			
<b>Guthega</b>	If you are an intermediate snow lover looking for a nice cocktail, try a taste of Bloody Mary; when you are done there, give Karl's a go to complete the mix.
