### Weather Top

-4°C. Snow flurries and cloudy skies for this Monday. Snow is being blown about the higher areas by moderate to strong winds. The expected top temperature between 9am and 3pm is +3°C.

### Weather Village

0°C. Cloud about, with breaks of blue. Winds are fresh and gusty. The expected top temperature between 9am and 3pm is +4°C.

### Snow Conditions

The snow cover has set up nicely thanks to the low overnight temperatures. The groomers have done an outstanding job of preparing the slopes today. The trails will be firm early topped with a little wind-blown snow, it will soften up quickly on the middle to lower mountain.

### Snow Riding

Good fun top to bottom riding for all levels today, make sure you layer up against the wind. Runs to head for today: More advanced go straight to the Supertrail, make sure you check out World Cup and True Blue on the way down. The Tors up around Karels is also well worth a look. Intermediate riders, make your way to the blue and green run haven of the Cruiser, Ballroom and Walkabout the tip. High Noon also in good shape. Friday Flat is groomed and ready for first timers, beginners and the littlies.

### Terrain Parks

Take your tricks to the next level on the many features in the terrain parks; High Noon Intermediate Terrain Park features a 30ft jump, 40ft jump, 6m lift tower tube, down flat down box, wall ride, pole jam 6m, stall pipe. The Cruiser Beginner Terrain Park has two 5ft jumps, a 10ft jumps, a 15 ft jump, a 20ft jump, 8m down box, flat/down box, 6m dance floor, and 6m flat box. Wombat World at Friday Flat includes tunnels, rollers and a small jump for the kids. The Monster Bagjump will not open today.
